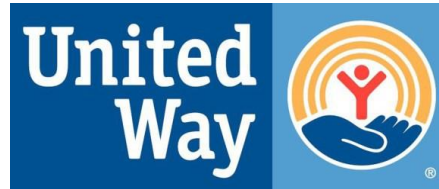

Who Does My Donation Help?

Your donation helps our friends and neighbors who are working hard—usually 2 or more jobs—yet still struggling to make ends meet. United Way calls this population **ALICE**. ALICE stands for **Asset Limited, Income Constrained, yet Employed**. Your gift provides the resources ALICE needs to overcome the cycle of poverty.

 **41%** of households in our community are experiencing poverty

UWVP's **Community Assistance Network (CAN)** provides **advocacy and referral services** to residents of the Virginia Peninsula facing poverty-related crises. Through this network, UWVP employs advocates who connect families with resources and support systems that address immediate needs as well as long-term services to lift people out of poverty.
